

## Financial supports for the 15 European students of EuroAqua

The European students entering the EuroAqua master course could be supported with the following grants:

For the first academic year:

- An Erasmus grant for 12 months (even if they have already received a similar support during a previous degree). Amount: about 75 €/month.
- A grant equivalent to the previous Erasmus grant offered jointly by the University of Nice – Sophia Antipolis and the local government of Nice. Amount: about 75 €/month.

For the second academic year:

- A Erasmus Mundus grant of 3,100 € for a mobility stay of 3 months with one of the partners of the EuroAqua consortium:
  - National University of Singapore (Singapore),
  - Swiss Federal Institute of Technology Lausanne (EPFL - Switzerland)
  - Eidgenössische Technische Hochschule Zürich (ETHZ- Switzerland),
  - National University of the Riverside (Santa Fe - Argentina),
  - Indian Institute of Technology Madras (India).
- The participants have the possibility to realize a professional practice for the last semester of the master course. A Leonardo grant of 400 €/month can be offered to the participant if this period is realized with one European company. Of course, additional financial supports and facilities (housing, ...) could be offered by the company during this period.
